Grade Specific Required Books –

Families should expect to spend between \$40-\$70 per student, per year, to purchase the great books required for their student's reading and coursework. We believe strongly that students owning certain great books from our curriculum, and building a library of them, is a necessary part of their education. It communicates to them that these books are worth thinking deeply about, writing in, and re-reading in the future. It also allows teachers to instruct students how to read closely and thoughtfully, and how to mark up their books, a skill that will be helpful to them in the future.

Please note that other supplies may be requested by individual teachers during the school year with sufficient time for your student to obtain them.
